## **Columbus Courts**

Council #1107 has an opening for a member of the Council to serve as a Director on the Board of Directors of Columbus Courts Inc. The term is from July 1st, 2008 to June 30th, 2010.

The Board of Directors of Columbus Courts is composed of 8 members each from Winnipeg (St. John Brebeuf) Council #1107 and St. Ignatius of Loyola Council #5808. Additionally the Grand Knights of each of these Councils serves as an ex-officio member of the Board. The Board manages the operation of this senior's high-rise, located at 253 Edgeland Blvd, in Tuxedo. The Board reports to the Manitoba Housing Authority, the building owners. The 18 member Board meets on the 1st Wednesday of the month from September to June. The Board sets policy for the building and oversees the administration of the facility. The day to day management of the facility is overseen by a paid manager.

Each year, in June, the term of one half of the Directors expires. These members have to be elected for an additional two year term or in the case of a resignation a new member from the Council has to be presented for election. This June, the two year term of Director Leonard Schmidt comes to an end. Leonard does not wish to be considered for another term. If you are interested in this position, please advise the Grand Knight. If more than one person is interested, there will be an election at the June 12th Council meeting to determine the Council's representative.
