We are continually increasing our customer base as the year has progressed and the indication is that it will only continue to improve.

We have taken this fundraiser to another level where we are partnering with St. John Brebeuf Parish in the support of Winnipeg Harvest. (see enclosed insert). It is our intention to officially launch this part of the fundraiser in the week prior to the start of lent. We will arrange to have David Northcott of Winnipeg Harvest to introduce the program at that time. In the meantime we have placed an insert in the parish bulletin and have advertised the program at the K of C table. Since that time we have been able to donate \$ 400.00 of Sobeys Gift Coupons.
